## **American Legion Auxiliary – Post #205 Higher Education Scholarship**

### Scholarship Eligibility

The candidate must be at least a graduating senior enrolled in a Erie/Niagara county high school attending college in the 2023/2024 school year. The student must be a direct or adopted descendent of/or relation to a member of the American Legion.

### Amount

Up to 3 \$1,000 scholarships (\$500 per semester) will be awarded per year. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA to maintain scholarship for second semester award.

### Application Requirements

- Application (see below)
- Essay
  - Provide a type-written 300-500-word paper about how you will apply your education and/or leadership opportunities in higher education to promote justice, freedom, democracy, and loyalty.
- 1-page resume of experiences
- Most recent report card or transcript
- Accredited college/university acceptance letter (due by time of award if selected)
