The North Tonawanda School District today announced an amendment to its policy for serving meals for children served under the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program for the 2023-2024 school year, which would allow for all children at all schools/sites to be served meals at no charge. The eligible schools include: Spruce Elementary, Drake Elementary, Ohio Elementary, North Tonawanda Intermediate School, North Tonawanda Middle School, and North Tonawanda High School.
