Missing an Exam Due to Medical Illness

NTMS is following New York State Education Department guidelines regarding student absence from exams. A student who is absent from an exam (or portion of an exam) must present a doctor's note (script) within 24 hours of the exam or portion of exam (or a time specified by a building administrator to the parent/guardian). The doctor's script must indicate that the student was seen and/or treated by the physician and was physically unable to attend school to take the exam.

This includes the following:

- Local Exams
- Regents Exams

If medical verification is not presented to a building administrator within 24 hours of the start of the exam, the student will receive a grade of zero (0).

Exam Timeline and Transportation Information

Morning Exams:

Students that receive district transportation will report to their bus pickup location at their normal time

- 7:30 Students enter NTMS through Door 8 (gym) and report to their exam locations.
- 9:30 The earliest time that students may be dismissed from the exam site. Students that are finished and receive transportation will report to the café to wait for buses. Students may bring a book to read. Students arriving after 9:30 will not be permitted into the exam site.
- 10:30 All students without extended time testing accommodations must finish their exam. Students that receive transportation will board buses to return home.
- 11:30 Students who are eligible for transportation and receive extended time testing accommodations through an IEP, 504, or an English Language Learner plan will have access to a late bus run to return home.

Afternoon Exams:

Students that receive district transportation will report to their bus pickup location no later than 11:00

- 11:30 Students enter NTMS through Door 8 (gym) and report to their exam locations.
- 1:30 The earliest time that students may be dismissed from the exam site. Students that are finished and receive transportation will report to the café to wait for buses. Students may bring a book to read. Students arriving after 1:30 will not be permitted into the exam site.
- 2:30 All students without extended time testing accommodations must finish their exam. Students that receive transportation will board buses to return home.
- 3:30 Students who are eligible for transportation and receive extended time testing accommodations through an IEP, 504, or an English Language Learner plan will have access to a late bus run to return home.
