This Week's Focus

Reading- Our new Guided Reading groups are in full swing and students are participating in meaningful literary discussions during each meeting. Daily 5 rotations are routine in our classroom, with this being a favorite time for students. I am so impressed with how much our stamina for independent reading and writing has built!

Writing - Many students have found a love in creative writing. We have crafted a class book titled "Snow Day" in which students created a fiction tale of waking up to a snow day. They describe in detail their feelings on the night before and morning of, and give numerous ideas of fun filled activities that they participate in on their day off!

Math- We have become proficient in adding two digit numbers with and without regrouping. Our biggest challenge throughout this unit has been our fluency in math facts. Many of our errors occur because we do not know the correct sum. Please be sure to keep practicing those math facts!
