

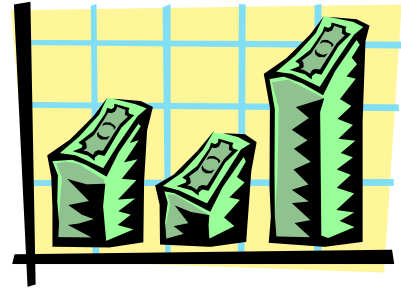
AOF Financial Literacy

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Course Description

Students will learn how to set personal financial goals and how to create a budget; as well as learning about the factors that shape them. This course also covers time-and-money relationships and tax reduction strategies. Financial Literacy concentrates on saving, borrowing, credit, and all types of insurance. Various types of investments are discussed. The course also addresses retirement and estate planning.
